I. Our Preeminent Responsibility. (10-11)

Our purpose is the presentation of the Gospel and the praise of His Glory.

- The reality of *Hell* (10)
- The rescue of the *deceived* (11a)
- The restraint of the *stumbling* (11b)

II. Our Persistent Resistance. (12a)

The clarity of the call is contorted by our consistent rebellion.

- We disregard our *mandate*
- We defend our *muddling*
- We disqualify our *message*
- We delay our *moment*
- We defame other *messengers*

III. Our Promised Reckoning. (12b)

We cannot escape our responsibility to share.

What is the greater tragedy?

- That we go to our grave without sharing?
- That our loved ones go to their grave without hearing?

Application to Life:

God left no doubt in His Word when it comes to our responsibility in sharing His love. What will you do with the truth that God's revealed today? The Father used *someone* to share His love with you. Will you
