It's hard to capture in words all that the Lord has done this past week in VBS...but it has been a Big Apple Blessing! In excess of 230 enrolled (nearly 100 workers!) and attendance remained strong all week. With the help of our counselors, eight (8) children, that we know of, prayed to receive Christ as their Savior. Over \$500 was collected in our Penny Wars to help with the disaster relief in our area. Family Night on Thursday was well attended and three (3) more decisions were made for Christ! How grateful we are for every worker. A special thank you goes out to Vicki Hughes, Cheryl Stephens, Angela Price and Bro. Russ for coordinating the effort over the course of this past year.

This Sunday will be our annual Faith and Freedom Sunday. An exciting day of patriotic worship has been planned. We'll have a color guard and recognize all our veterans. The Holy Spirit has laid a special message on my heart. Certainly these are perilous days for America...how desperately we need revival! Be in your place and invite a friend.

There is a great number signed up for children's camp this year. Bro Russ has put together an affordable alternative to the more expensive camps in the past. Be sure to be in prayer that God would do a significant work in the hearts of our children.

Let me take this opportunity to update you on my Sunday Morning Sermon Series. We just completed A Family Worth Loving. On July 10th we'll launch our next series in Colossians – A Faith Worth Learning. This will be a survey of the non-negotiables of the faith.
